



JHU Online Program in the History of Medicine Course Registration 2022

Greetings! Registration for courses in the Online Program in the History of Medicine at Johns Hopkins University has gone through a few changes since the last academic year. The School of Medicine has migrated both application and registrations systems starting Fall 2022.

We appreciate your patience as we navigate these new processes together.

1. Have you taken a course with us prior to July 2022 and received a JHED ID?
 - a. Yes. Please skip to step 3.
 - b. No. Please go to step 2.
2. If you have not taken a course with us, as of July 2022, you will need to reapply through our new system.
 - a. Go to <https://www.hopkinsmedicine.org/som/education-programs/graduate-programs/admissions/online-programs/>
 - b. Click the “Admissions Application” button
 - c. You’ll need to create an account to start a new application.
 - d. Choose “non-degree” and then “History of Medicine (courses).”
 - e. You should get your acceptance results via email within 2 business days.
 - f. Once you have received and set up your JHED ID, please continue to step 3.
3. Please log in at my.jh.edu with your JHED ID and password.
 - a. If you are able to log in successfully without issue, please skip to step 4.
 - b. If you cannot remember your password, please click “forgot password?” in the top right corner of the page and follow the instructions.
 - c. If you are not able to log in successfully, please email ihomonline@jhmi.edu and provide us with both your JHED ID and the error message that you received. Students who have not taken courses recently or are on leave of absence will need to be reinstated before registering and we can initiate that process.
4. Once we know your JHED ID is working correctly, please go to [SIS Self-Service](#) and register for courses.
